Albury Quiz & Curry Night

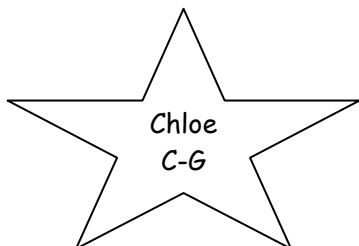

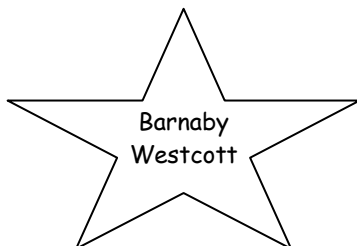

Class 1



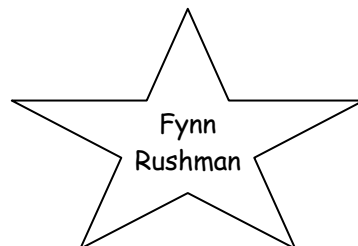
For producing a great final piece of instruction writing.
